Komfort Kart Volunteers & Items Needed

WELCOME NEW APPLICANT!

We appreciate your interest in the Riley Hospital Volunteer Program and look forward to working with you to complete the required steps to becoming a Riley Hospital for Children Volunteer.

Our on-boarding process consists of a background check, interview, health screening, and a volunteer orientation. IU Health pays all fees pertaining to the on-boarding process. We have this process to protect volunteers, patients, families, visitors, and staff and to ensure patient confidentiality, a safe environment, and quality care. Our on-boarding process consists of the following:

- Application and Interview
- Health screening
- Orientation
- Background check

STEP ONE: Application and Interview

Please go to the volunteer website www.rileychildrens.org/about/volunteer to learn more about volunteering at Riley Hospital for Children at IU Health and use the "Apply Now" link to submit your online application.

As a member of Kiwanis, you have already interviewed with your local Kiwanis Club and will **NOT** need to schedule another interview with Volunteer Resources.

STEP TWO: Health Screening

All new IU Health Volunteers are asked to complete a Health Screening at IU Health Employee Occupational Health Services (EOHS) at the Methodist Tower Building. Information for scheduling the Health Screening is attached to this email. All pages of the packet should be taken with you to your health screening appointment.

STEP THREE: Orientation

Please schedule an orientation session using this link: <https://www.signupgenius.com/go/4090c48abaf23abfa7-riley2> (Copy and paste into your browser if this email does not allow you to click.) You are NOT required to create an account with the signup genius site, simply select a date and time.

STEP FOUR: Background Check

A background check will be conducted for all applicants 18 and older. The background check will be initiated when the first four steps have been completed. You will receive an email request from Sterling Volunteers to submit information to their secure system for completion of this step.

STEP FIVE: Prepare for service as a Riley Volunteer!

After your background check has been completed, you will receive an e-introduction to Marge Crouch who will be supervising and scheduling your service. Marge will contact you to arrange your start date.
